ACTIVITIES OVERVIEW

FRIDAY NYTE FIRE

(Friday preceding 4th Sunday)

Friday evenings focus on the second portion of the overall church mission of “reaching in to continue the change” by offering activities that ignite FIRE (fellowship, interaction, relationships and encouragement).

- **“Ignite the Fire” Themed Discussions:** Peer-to-peer discussions and interaction based on various topics including our church’s monthly themes, themed small group studies, and issues surrounding friends, family, school and community.
- **Application and Homework Assistance:** Dedicated to the completion of scholarships, college and employment applications, as well as assisting with homework, resumes and personal bios.
- **Young Parents and Couples:** These sessions will provide guidance and instruction to young married couples and married or single parents.
- **Self-Care and Etiquette:** These sessions are designed to teach our youth about proper self-care and etiquette in everyday life and public settings. Pastor will speak with the young ladies and Bro. Charles will speak with the young men.
- **Fun and Games:** End of School Bash, Game Night, Harvest Social, etc.
- **Skit/Play Rehearsal:** Providing an opportunity for up-and-coming writers, directors, graphic artists, costumers and actors to express themselves. Skits/Plays will be performed before the congregation on a 4th Sunday.
- **Movies and Munchies:** A night of new releases and snacks (ie pizza, fruit, nachos, popcorn, and beverages)

"SPREAD THE FIRE" OUTREACH

(Saturday preceding 4th Sunday)

SUNDAY MORNIN' FIRE

(4th Sunday)

Sunday mornings are all about the next generation of those on fire for God...GeneratioNext!

On this day, attire is comfortable for the entire congregation (i.e. jeans, athletic or flat shoes, denim skirts, and youth ministry paraphernalia, etc.) and the youth are encouraged fully participate in every aspect of the worship service including:

As encouragement to strive for the best, reach goals and achieve all that God has destined, each month we will highlight a "GeneratioNext FIRE Starter". This individual will be acknowledged for their accomplishments in the church, their family, school and/or community.

To further enhance the youth experience, some Youth Sundays will be themed wherein the congregation will be asked to participate by wearing certain attire. For instance a) Time for Battle (military attire) or b) God of All Ages (1950s or 1970s attire).
